**Daniel Frondorf Re-elected to National ASPE Board**  
***Named Central Plains Governor of American Society of Professional Estimators***

**Cincinnati, OH** – Daniel Frondorf, CPE and Principal of DG Frondorf and Associates, LLC, has been re-elected to the 2011 – 2013 Board of Trustees for the American Society of Professional Estimators (ASPE).
